Natsu akane (Summer Darter)

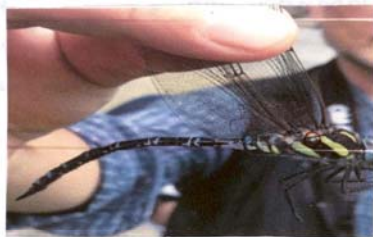
A lot of honeycombed
