- Fishing is prohibited.

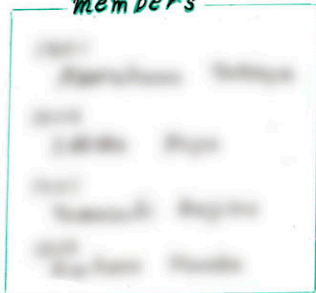
